Entry Guidelines

ELIGIBILITY

The competition is open to all Seychellois national, professional and amateur, regardless of age, sex or religion.

Entry is limited to original photos that have not formerly been displayed or exhibited and to which the entrant holds all applicable rights.

Image data files shall be created with digital still cameras (including medium and large-format cameras). Images that have been retouched using software or by other means will be accepted. Both color and monochrome images will be accepted.

SUBMISSION:

Submission should be on a CD or DVD which should be labeled with the participant's name, age, address and a word document with a brief explanation of the photo in a few words. All printing will be taken care of by the Chinese Embassy.

File format: JPEG/TIF

File size per JPEG: more than 1500 x 2100 pixels/more than 150dpi/Up to 20 MB

The standard color for the judging process is RGB.

Number of entries is restricted to five different photographs per photographer. In the exhibition a maximum of three photographs by the same photographer will be permitted.
